PE Uniform

All students are expected to participate in PE lessons whilst at Manor School and to do so must be wearing the correct attire that is suitable for the location and activity being undertaken. It is the student's responsibility to ensure they have the correct clothing for their lesson.

Standard expectations:

- Reversible maroon/light blue top or a royal blue polo t-shirt
- Navy blue plain shorts
- Navy blue plain skort
- Navy blue plain tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue plain sweatshirt (no hood)
- Navy blue plain zipped fleece/sweatshirt (no hood)
- Navy blue football/hockey socks

Protective items recommended for specific activities:

- Football boots (moulded studs only for the 3G pitch)
- Shin pads (particularly for football and hockey)
- Gum shields (particularly for hockey and rugby)

Additional items permitted due to adverse weather conditions:

- Cold weather: woolly hats, gloves, plain navy waterproof rain jackets (no scarves)
- Hot weather: sun hats
- Students who are part of the leadership academy or the school dance academy are permitted to wear their given uniform due to these items of clothing being embroidered with the school logo
- Navy plain sports baselayer leggings and long sleeved tops are permitted

Health and Safety:

- Students are advised to bring bottles of water and inhalers out to lessons
- Appropriate footwear is also an essential part of the PE uniform

Items not permitted under any circumstance:

- Outdoor coats
- Branded jumpers, sweatshirts and zipped tops
- Hooded jumpers

All students are required to change into their PE Uniform for **all** lessons regardless of ability to participate. The school will require parents/carers to recognise and comply with the school policy. If your child is well enough to be in school, they will be expected to change and be involved in the physical education lesson to the best of their ability. If your child is unable to participate fully within physical education, please provide a doctor/hospital note dated and signed for the duration of time they are unable to take part. This will be recorded by the physical education team and provision will be put in place to ensure they are able to access lessons through coaching/officiating and additional roles whilst still in their full PE uniform.
